In 2023, LPC now has a new official online website at <u>London Pickleball Club</u>, under the Pickleball Canada club database. At the admin level, the site allows the club to communicate with all active LPC members via the mass email system for creating events, leagues, tournaments, clinics, and even an online LPC Pickleball store is in the works. At the club player level, it has all the essential tools and links to book your pickleball play at different LPC venues, locations and play time listings, membership renewal, and even videos of how to use the new Global Pickleball Network (GPN) booking system.

Our LPC Global Pickleball Network (GPN) <u>LPC London Pickleball Club</u> now has 122 registered members. The system also allows you to be placed on a waiting list if the event is fully booked.

Indoor Venues



LPC and the interest in pickleball in London is growing rapidly and we are running out of spaces to play. Starting in June LPC has booked four courts at True North Courts and this will run for three months on Tuesday evenings from 6-8. The City of London is constructing four courts in White Oaks Park, adding lines to courts in Rowntree and Glanworth Parks, and Foxfield Park is under the second phase of construct that will include four pickleball courts.
